

# Drama

FETAC L6 (Minor Award)



## Content

This is a one year part-time practical course in Drama. Students have the opportunity to attain a FETAC Level 6 Minor Award in Drama. This award is particularly applicable to areas such as Childcare and Drama in Education.

The curriculum is designed to enable the students to use drama confidently and effectively as a tool to enhance development across the spectrum of potential client groups with whom the learner may be working, and to empower the client group to create and perform a theatrical piece.

Students will be able to communicate on an imaginative and creative level by exploring the voice and body as a means of expression. This award will equip learners with the skills and knowledge to plan and deliver a dramatic presentation.

The specific learning outcomes are grouped into three units:

- Improvisation
- Storytelling
- Performance

## Assessment

Assessment takes place both throughout the course and with a concluding practical demonstration.

Assessment is by means of written projects, assignments, and a demonstration of performance and communication ability.
