

Childcare Management

Content

This is a part-time course in Childcare Management. Participants have the opportunity to attain a FETAC level 6 award in Supervision in Childcare. The award prepares participants to perform a supervisory role in creches, playgroups or childcare settings, in both the private and community sector. Tuition is provided in the practical and theoretical aspects of childcare. The syllabus is structured as follows:

- **Early Childhood Programmes** : Examines the key organisational skills required to run early childhood education programmes for children 0 - 6 years.
- **Social and Legal Issues in Childcare** : Teaching focuses on the social policy and legal issues relevant to early childhood education.
- **Supervision in Childcare** : This module investigates the managerial skills required to run childcare centres.
- **Child Development** : Instruction given on methods of carrying out structured observations of children.

Assessment

Assessment takes place both during the course and by examination.

Assessment includes written projects, class assignments and practical demonstrations. Participants are advised to familiarise themselves with the FETAC assessment protocols as well as the submission deadlines pertaining to each module. These may be accessed at www.fetac.ie.

- Saturday workshops

Entry Requirements

Applications are invited from the following:

- Managers or those with supervisory roles in the Childcare sector.
- Holders of a FETAC Level 5 award in Childcare.
- Mature applicants who have relevant training or experience.

Additional requirements include:

- All students are required to organise 40 hours' work experience in a Childcare, Playgroup or Pre-School setting.

Application Procedures

Application is by enrolment. Enrolment dates are provided in this brochure. Students will receive a course briefing upon commencement.
