- A reduction of 10% in fees will apply to those in receipt of social protection payments, students and those over 65. Please state this when enrolling. Proof of entitlement to reduction will be required.
- It is the responsibility of students to make themselves aware of the entry requirements, examination dates and examination fees due for their course. Tutors will inform students of all examination entry requirements in advance.
- We welcome students aged 16 and over at time of enrolment. We regret that we cannot accept students below the age of 16. Students over age 70 should consult HSE guidelines if considering attending a course 'live' in the College.


