

Micro-credentials are a new and exciting academic offering from Trinity College. They are short, accredited learning experiences that facilitate flexible and innovative professional development and lifelong learning.

Is it for me?

This micro-credential will be relevant to any multiprofessional staff working in healthcare design and delivery across all grades and all services. This cohort includes nurses, midwives, paramedics and other allied healthcare professionals.

What does it cover?

This micro-credential allows healthcare professionals to understand the application of digital health technology. One example is the adoption of the electronic patient records. The content is varied; therefore you will learn to develop a critical understanding of digital health will allow to prepare and apply the knowledge to a real-world problem.

How is it delivered?

This micro-credential will be delivered in a blended format. Learners will take part in in-person tutorials and attend online classes. Two in-person days will be expected during the 12 weeks. Online resources will be available to students.
