Micro-credentials are a new and exciting academic offering from Trinity College.

They are short, accredited learning experiences that facilitate flexible and innovative professional development and lifelong learning.

Is it for me?

This micro-credential is for registered nurses/midwives who prescribe medications, prescribers working in other jurisdictions who wish to prescribe in Ireland. Successful completion of this micro-credential addresses the mandatory regulatory requirement for registration as a nurse/midwife prescriber with NMBI.

What does it cover?

This micro-credential covers content relating to professional accountability and responsibility in relation to nurse prescribing. Learners will explore legislation relevant to the practice of nurse prescribing and learn how to make decisions around prescribing, as a multi-professional team member.

How is it delivered?

This micro-credential is delivered in a blended format. Learners will benefit from a mix of live and recorded lectures. Online resources will be available to students to facilitate flexible self-directed study.
